Modernizing Land Administration

Technology advances in cadastre, mapping and valuation

Most countries in the world are working towards modernizing their land administration systems – cadastre, national mapping, and valuation. Ongoing challenges include—keeping authoritative land information current, complete, accurate, and secure while providing access to data across multiple networks to multiple stakeholders. Legacy technology puts up barriers that inhibit access to data across ministries, departments, and municipal and national offices.
