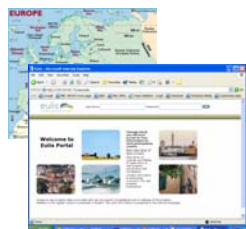

- Easy to add new participants

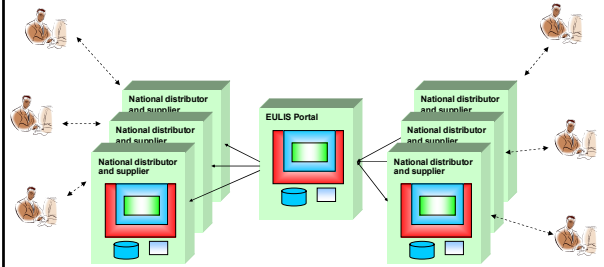

Technical overview

- The portal contains
 - descriptive information
 - functions for transfer of information needed for charging and billing purposes
- The land and cadastral information itself remains in the national registers, although presented in the portal
 - The register information presented is accurate, updated and reliable as in the National Register
