SUMMARY

The United Nations calls for enhanced cooperation on global geodesy. In February 2015 the UN General Assembly adopted the resolution “a global geodetic reference frame for sustainable development”. Based on this resolution the UN Committee of Experts on Global Geospatial Information Management at its sixth session in New York August 2016, endorsed the roadmap for the Global Geodetic Reference Frame (GGRF) and welcomed the development of an implementation plan to ensure that the recommendations contained in the road map are linked to national policy developments in the area of geodesy.
