

The Activities of GUGIK During the Pandemic

SUMMARY

During pandemic Head Office of Geodesy and Cartography (GUGiK) was very active on working on opening the data from the Central Geodetic and Cartographic Resource and also on digitization geodesy and easy access to data. All users can download open data without any limitations. All works concentrated on legislation and amendment of Geodetic and Cartographic Law and connected 14 regulations.

The amendment of the Geodetic and Cartographic Law this is also 14 regulations that were issued within one year. According to our regulation only until 31 of December last year was allowed to produce paper documentation on land surveying works. Changes in law it is also improvements for land surveyors and acceleration of investment and construction process in Poland. The most important is the introduction of web services as the primary forms of data publication (WMS) and its sharing (WFS).

To make easier use of our data we have provided simple solutions for downloading the data in the geoportal.gov.pl service. 605 TB of opened spatial data was downloaded in 2021, almost twice as much as in 2020.

Through easy access to data we also consider trainings and education in the SDI field. During pandemic we were also to conduct training project – POWER. Through POWER project from the basics of SDI in the online mode close to 1000 participants was trained. We were also organizing training sessions prepared to popularize use of geoportal.gov.pl and connected services Only last year GUGiK organized 17 videoconferences and almost

5 000 employees of polish administration sector took part in the geoportal trainings.
